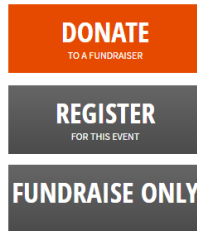


# Setting Up a Tour de Crème Fundraising Page

Go to the Tour de Crème page on Crowdrise: [www.crowdrise.com/TourdeCreme2018](http://www.crowdrise.com/TourdeCreme2018). It's secure.



If you have already registered, click “Fundraise Only”.

If you're joining someone else's team, click “Join a Team” and find the team that way. To create your own fundraising page, click “Start Your Own Fundraiser”.

Fill in some basic information and click “Submit.”

You'll be prompted to add a photo. You can do that now or later. To do so later, click “Skip Step”.



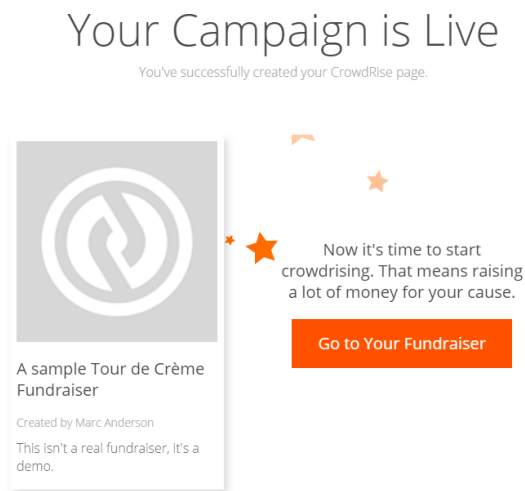
